1. **Power Button** – Turn on/off the device.

- 5. **Type C USB Port** The USB cable connects here to charge and data transfer.
- 6. **Vent Holes** Ventilation holes to cool down the device.
- 7. **Battery Cover** Battery is inside the battery cover.
- 8. **Battery Cover Notch** Lift the notch to open the battery cover.
